Franklin D. Roosevelt is reported to have said of the Nicaraguan dictator, Anastasio Somoza,

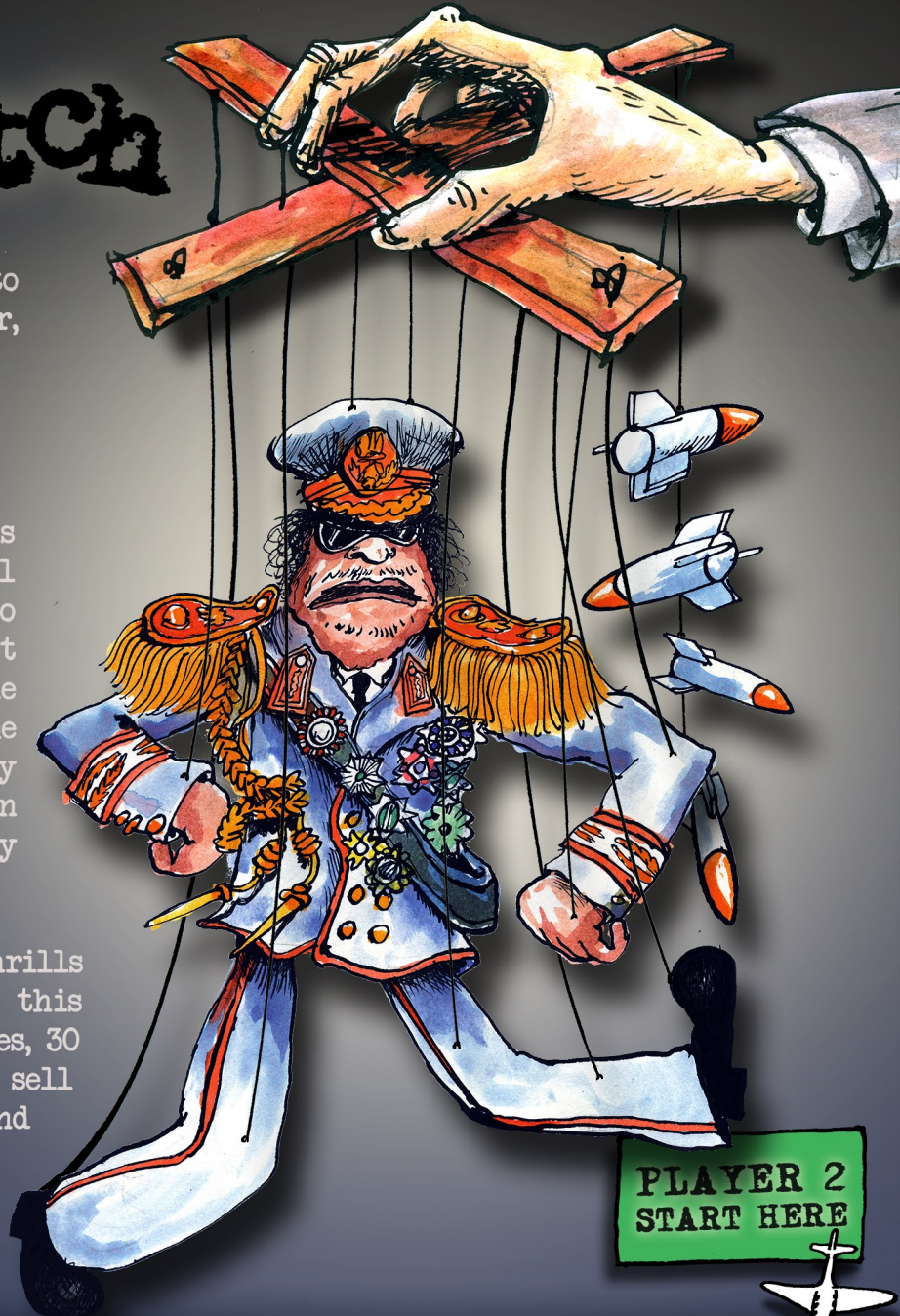
"He may be a son of a bitch, but he's OUR son of a bitch"
